Successfully completing the first year of training will allow you to continue training as a full candidate towards certification as a Jungian analyst. The essay portions of this application provide an opportunity to let us know more about you personally as well as your professional expectations. Please be both complete and succinct in your responses. As the application process moves along, members of the admissions committee will be speaking with you directly which will give more time for expanded descriptions or explanations. We hope this is the beginning of a significant and deeply meaningful journey in your life.

Applicants are advised to carefully read the section on our website under *Education* and then *Analyst Training Program*, which outlines requirements for membership and for admission to the training program. The application form is divided into four parts. Part I and II are relatively straightforward and objective. Part III is in essay format. It allows you to present objective facts in a subjective manner. This section of the application form is not meant to be a novella, but rather to begin to give us a "flavor" of who you are as a person. Please keep each section of Part III as concise as possible while allowing room for a response you consider authentic to your own style and personality. Part IV is the Appendix.

The appendix information is an essential part of the application form. All of its parts must be included or, where applicable, sent directly to the Institute. The appendix must include: Verification of analytical hours. Copy the blank form in the appendix, send it to your analyst(s), and have them send it back directly to the Institute.

- 2. License to Practice in California. Attach a photocopy of your license. If you are very close to licensing, please explain when you think you will be licensed.
- 3. Evidence of Professional Liability insurance.
- 4. Letters of Reference. Have three letters of reference sent directly to the institute.
- 5. Resume/Curriculum Vitae. Include a copy of your resume or curriculum vitae.
